

FREIGHT SERVICE

RULE 24. THROUGH AND UNASSIGNED FREIGHT SERVICE-RATES. (a) For service paid the through freight rates under the schedule in effect, the basic daily rates shall be the rates as follows: See current rate sheets for per mile and per day rates in effect for freight conductors and brakemen. Rate sheets will be maintained to reflect national agreements.

(b) The basic daily rates of pay for conductors and brakemen in road freight service receiving road rates of pay shall be increased as follows:

Basis of Pay

Maximum number of cars (including caboose) hauled in train in road movement at any one time on road trip anywhere between initial starting point and point of final release

Amounts to be added to basic daily rate as provided for in paragraph (a) of this rule.
